

Rosa's Spanish Number Fact-File

Learning objective: To practise writing and using Spanish numbers from 1 to 20.

Hello! I am Rosa. Let's learn to count in Spanish! Look at the Spanish numbers in the word bank. Fill in the fact-file below to show what you have learned. You can use the sentence starters to help you write your answers.

Word bank: uno (1) · dos (2) · tres (3) · cuatro (4) · cinco (5) · seis (6) · siete (7) · ocho (8) · nueve (9) · diez (10) · once (11) · doce (12) · trece (13) · catorce (14) · quince (15)

1. My favourite number: Write your favourite number in English and then write it in Spanish. (2 marks)

2. Counting treats: If I have 5 apples and buy 3 more, how many do I have? Write the total in Spanish. (2 marks)

3. Shopping trip: If a toy costs £7, how do you write the number 7 in Spanish? (1 mark)

4. Number sequence: Write the Spanish words for the numbers 1, 2, and 3 in the correct order. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you draw a picture of 4 stars and write the word 'cuatro' next to them?
