

Rosa the Parrot's Spanish Number Challenge

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish numbers from 1 to 20.

Hello! I am Rosa. Let's learn to count in Spanish. Read the Spanish word and write the number in digits. Use the word bank below to help you.

Word bank: uno (1) · dos (2) · tres (3) · cuatro (4) · cinco (5) · seis (6) · siete (7) · ocho (8) · nueve (9) · diez (10)

1. Rosa has 'tres' feathers. Write the number in digits: (1 mark)

2. Write the Spanish word for the number 5: (1 mark)

3. If you have 'seis' apples and you buy 'cuatro' more, how many do you have in total? Write the answer in Spanish: (2 marks)

4. Max the monkey wants to buy 'diez' bananas. Write the number 10 in Spanish: (1 mark)

5. Match the Spanish word 'ocho' to its digit: (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of 7 bright flowers in a garden. Label your drawing with the Spanish word for 7.



Extension challenge: Can you count to 20 out loud with a partner? Try to write down the Spanish word for the number 12.
