

¡Qué opinas! (What do you think?)

Master the art of expressing your opinion in Spanish with Rosa the Parrot!

- To say you really love something, start your sentence with 'Me encanta'.
- Use 'Me gusta' followed by the item to say what you like.
- Add 'mucho' to the end of your sentence to say you like something a lot.
- Use 'No me gusta' to express that you do not like something.
- Add 'nada' after 'No me gusta' to show you do not like something at all.
- Use the word 'también' at the end of a sentence to say 'me too'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, when you say you like something, you are literally saying that the thing 'is pleasing' to you. That is why we use the word 'Me' (to me) at the start of our sentences!
