

Rosa's Opinion Journal: Mi Opinión

Learning objective: To use Spanish opinion phrases and adjectives to express likes and dislikes about hobbies and school subjects.

Rosa the parrot wants to know what you think! Use this template to practise your Spanish. Choose a subject or hobby, pick an opinion phrase from the word bank, and add a reason why. Remember to check your spellings and use the correct masculine or feminine adjectives if you need to.

Word bank: Me gusta... (I like...) · No me gusta... (I do not like...) · Me encanta... (I love...) · Detesto... (I detest...) · porque es... (because it is...) · divertido/a (fun) · aburrido/a (boring) · interesante (interesting) · difícil (difficult) · fácil (easy)

1. Topic Selection: What hobby or school subject are you giving an opinion on today? Write it in Spanish (e.g., el fútbol, las matemáticas, la música). (2 marks)

2. The Opinion: Write a full sentence using an opinion phrase from the word bank to say how you feel about your chosen topic. (2 marks)

3. The Reason: Use 'porque es...' to explain why you feel that way. Try to include one adjective from the word bank. (3 marks)

4. Comparison: Use the word 'pero' (but) to add a second opinion about a different subject or hobby. (3 marks)

5. Rosa's Challenge: Can you write a question to ask a friend what they think? (Hint: Use '¿Qué te gusta...?' or '¿Te gusta...?') (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Choose two of your sentences and try to say them out loud to a partner with lots of expression! Can they guess if you like the subject just by the tone of your voice?
