

Year 4 Spanish Assessment: My School

Learning objective: To identify and write Spanish vocabulary related to school subjects and classroom items.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the Spanish words. Write your answers clearly on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends at school today. She loves to learn new words in Spanish to describe her classroom and what she studies.

Word bank: el estuche (pencil case) · el libro (book) · el patio (playground) · las matemáticas (maths) · la clase de arte (art class) · el profesor (the teacher) · tengo (I have) · mi escuela (my school)

1. 1. What is the Spanish word for 'maths'? Write your answer below. (2 marks)

2. 2. Translate this sentence into Spanish: 'I have a book.' (Use the word bank to help you). (3 marks)

3. 3. Which room in the school do you go to for painting and drawing? Write the Spanish phrase. (4 marks)

4. 4. Rosa is in the playground. What is the Spanish word for 'playground'? (2 marks)

5. 5. Rosa is talking about her school. Write a short sentence in Spanish using 'mi escuela' to say 'My school is big.' (Hint: 'big' is 'grande'). (4 marks)

6. 6. Extended Writing: Write 3 sentences in Spanish about things you have in your school bag (e.g., 'I have a pencil case'). (10 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite item from your school bag and label it with its Spanish name from the word bank.
