

Rosa's Spanish School Bag

Learning objective: To identify and label common classroom objects in Spanish.

Rosa the parrot wants to pack her school bag! Follow the steps below to draw and label your own school items. Use the word bank to help you spell the Spanish words correctly.

Draw: Draw a large, colourful backpack in the middle of the paper. Around and inside the backpack, draw the following school items: a book, a pencil, a ruler, and a pencil case. Use clear lines and bright colours. Label each item with its correct Spanish name from the word bank provided.



Label words: el lápiz (pencil) · el libro (book) · la mochila (backpack) · la regla (ruler) · el estuche (pencil case)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large backpack (la mochila) in the centre of your page.
2. Step 2: Draw a book (el libro) and a pencil (el lápiz) next to the bag.
3. Step 3: Draw a ruler (la regla) and a pencil case (el estuche) inside the bag.
4. Step 4: Label each item you have drawn using the Spanish words from the word bank.
