- In Spanish, we say 'la escuela' when we talk about our school.
- If you want to say 'the book', you say 'el libro'.
- When you are doing your sums, you are studying 'las matemáticas'.
- Your teacher is called 'el profesor' in a Spanish classroom.
- To draw a picture, you use 'el lápiz', which means the pencil.
