Learning objective: To learn Spanish vocabulary for common food items and prices when shopping.

Draw: Draw a basket filled with the items Rosa bought: an apple (manzana), a loaf of bread (pan), and a block of cheese (queso).



Extension challenge: Imagine you are at the market with Rosa. Write a simple Spanish sentence using the word 'cuesta' to ask the price of an item, for example: 'El pan cuesta £1'.
