

Rosa's Spanish Shop Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use basic Spanish vocabulary related to shopping for food items.

Follow the steps below to draw your market stall. Use the words in the word bank to label your items in Spanish. You can use your coloured pencils to make your shop look bright and busy!

Draw: Draw a friendly market stall scene. The style should be clear and colourful. Include a large basket filled with fruit, a loaf of bread, and a price sign. Ensure there is enough space around the items to write the Spanish labels clearly.



Label words: la manzana (apple) · el plátano (banana) · el pan (bread) · el precio (price) · la cesta (basket)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large basket (la cesta) in the middle of your page. Label it.
2. Step 2: Draw two red apples (las manzanas) and one yellow banana (el plátano) inside the basket.
3. Step 3: Draw a loaf of bread (el pan) next to the basket.
4. Step 4: Draw a small sign next to the bread. Write '£2' on it and label it as the price (el precio).
