

Rosa's Spanish Shopping Trip

¡Vamos de compras! Let's go shopping with Rosa the parrot!

- To ask how much something costs, say: '¿Cuánto cuesta?'
- To say the price, use: 'Cuesta tres libras' (It costs £3).
- If an item is a good deal, you can say: '¡Es barato!'
- If an item costs too much, you can say: '¡Es caro!'
- When you buy something, remember to say: 'Gracias' (Thank you).

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish-speaking countries, people often use the Euro (€) as their currency, but when we learn Spanish in the UK, we can practise saying prices using our own currency, pounds (£)!
