

Rosa's Spanish Market Trip

Learning objective: To use basic Spanish vocabulary for shopping and prices in a simple role-play context.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a Spanish market. Help her buy some fruit! Use the word bank to fill in the gaps. Look at the prompts below to write your shopping list and total cost.

Word bank: la manzana (apple) · el plátano (banana) · la naranja (orange) · cuesta (costs) · muchas gracias (thank you) · uno (one) · dos (two) · tres (three)

1. Choose one fruit Rosa wants to buy and write the Spanish name here: (1 mark)

2. How many pieces of fruit does Rosa buy? Write the number in Spanish: (1 mark)

3. If the fruit costs £1, write: 'La fruta _____ £1'. (Use the word bank): (1 mark)
