Word bank: La manzana (apple) - £1 · El plátano (banana) - £2 · El pan (bread) - £3 · ¿Cuánto cuesta? (How much is it?) · Cuesta... (It costs...) · Por favor (Please) · Gracias (Thank you)

1. Rosa wants to buy an apple. Write the question she should ask the shopkeeper to find out the price. (2 marks)

2. The apple costs £1. Write the answer in Spanish using 'Cuesta...'. (2 marks)

3. If a banana costs £2, how would you say that in Spanish? (2 marks)

4. Complete this sentence to be polite: 'Un pan, _____.' (1 mark)

5. Write the Spanish word for 'bread' and 'banana'. (2 marks)
