

Rosa's Sporting Adventure in Spain

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary related to popular sports and express preferences using 'Me gusta' and 'No me gusta'.

Rosa the parrot wants to join a sports club, but she needs your help to match the Spanish words to the correct sports equipment. Once you have matched them, use the word bank to write sentences about which sports Rosa likes and dislikes based on her preferences.

Word bank: el fútbol (football) · el tenis (tennis) · el baloncesto (basketball) · la natación (swimming) · el ciclismo (cycling) · Me gusta... (I like...) · No me gusta... (I do not like...)

1. Draw a line to match the Spanish sport to its English translation: 1. El fútbol -> ? 2. La natación -> ? 3. El tenis -> ? (3 marks)

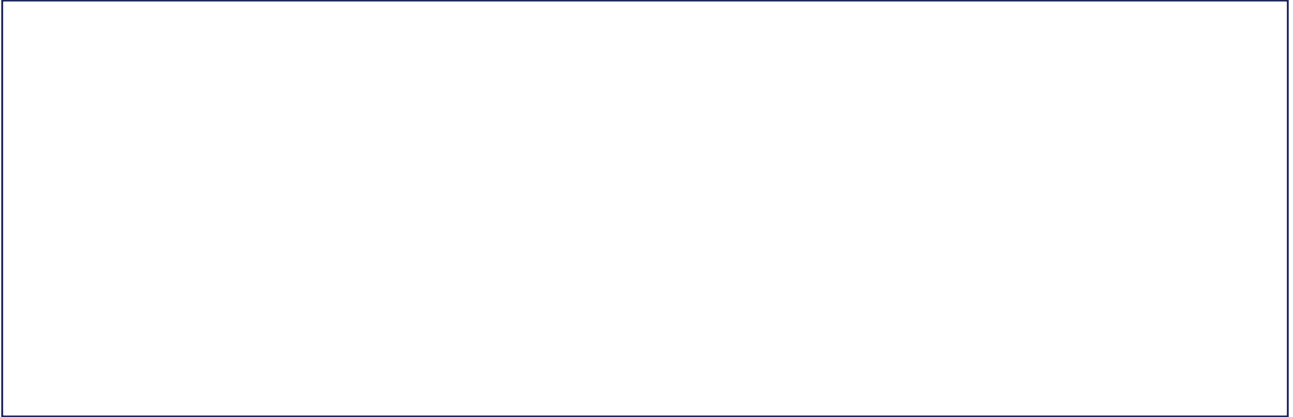
2. Rosa loves team games! Write a sentence in Spanish saying 'I like football' using the word bank. (2 marks)

3. Rosa is afraid of cold water. Write a sentence in Spanish saying 'I do not like swimming'. (2 marks)

4. If a tennis racket costs £12.50 and a football costs £8.75, how much would they cost in total? Show your working in your maths book. (2 marks)

5. Choose one other sport from the word bank and write a sentence about it in Spanish using 'Me gusta' or 'No me gusta'. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing a sports kit for her favourite activity. Label the items of clothing or equipment in Spanish.



Extension challenge: Research a famous Spanish sports player and write down their name and the sport they play. Why is this sport popular in Spain?
