

Year 5 Spanish Assessment: Mi Vida Deportiva (My Sports Life)

Learning objective: To identify and describe sports in Spanish, including preferences using 'me gusta' and 'no me gusta'.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers clearly in Spanish or English as requested. Rosa the parrot is cheering for you!

Rosa, the bilingual parrot, is training for the Jungle Sports Day. She says: '¡Hola! Me llamo Rosa. Me gusta mucho jugar al fútbol, pero no me gusta el tenis. Mi amigo Leo el león prefiere la natación porque es muy relajante.'

Word bank: jugar al fútbol - to play football · el baloncesto - basketball · la natación - swimming · el tenis - tennis · me gusta - I like · no me gusta - I do not like · practicar - to practise · cada día - every day

1. Using the passage, list two sports that Rosa mentions. (2 marks)

2. Translate these phrases into English: 'Me gusta la natación' and 'No me gusta el baloncesto'. (2 marks)

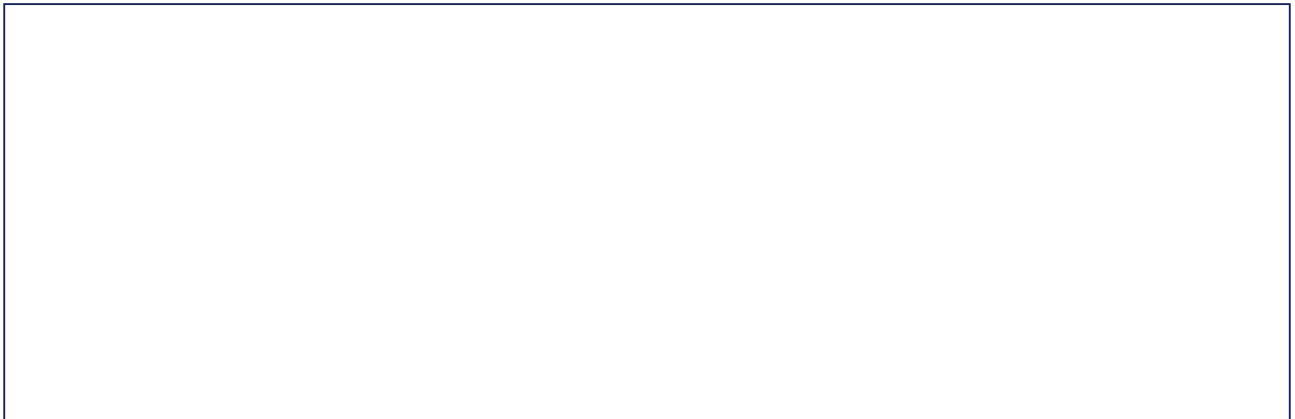
3. If you wanted to say 'I play football', which verb would you use? Write the full sentence in Spanish. (2 marks)

4. Explain why Leo the lion enjoys swimming according to the text. Write your answer in English. (2 marks)

5. Look at the list of sports provided. Which sport would you choose to play and why? Write three sentences in Spanish explaining your preference (e.g., 'Me gusta... porque es...'). (6 marks)

6. Extended Writing Task: Rosa is writing a short report about the Jungle Sports Day. Write a paragraph in Spanish (50-70 words) describing which sports are being played, which ones you like, and which ones you dislike. Use the vocabulary provided and include at least one connective (e.g., 'pero' or 'y'). (11 marks)
