

Rosa the Parrot's Spanish Time Check

Learning objective: To tell the time in Spanish using o'clock and half past.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the Spanish words. Write your answers on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot is learning to tell the time in Spanish. She wants to know when it is time for her morning snack and her afternoon flight. Help Rosa label the clocks correctly.

Word bank: Es la... · Son las... · en punto · y media · una · dos · tres · cuatro · cinco · seis

1. 1. Look at the clock showing 1:00. How do you say 'It is one o'clock' in Spanish? Start with 'Es la...' (2 marks)

2. 2. Look at the clock showing 3:00. How do you say 'It is three o'clock' in Spanish? Start with 'Son las...' (2 marks)

3. 3. Look at the clock showing 5:30. How do you say 'It is half past five' in Spanish? (2 marks)

4. 4. Match the time to the Spanish phrase. Draw a line or write the letter: A) 2:00, B) 6:30. 1) Son las dos en punto. 2) Son las seis y media. (4 marks)

5. 5. Rosa says: 'Son las cuatro y media.' What time is she saying? Write the time in numbers. (2 marks)

6. 6. Rosa is making a schedule for her day. She eats at 2:00 and flies at 4:30. Write these two times in Spanish using a full sentence for each. (8 marks)

7. 7. Imagine you are Rosa. Write 5 sentences about your day using times. You can use: 'A las... (At...)' or 'Es la...'. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a clock face showing 6:00 and label it 'Son las seis en punto' underneath.
