

Rosa the Parrot's Guide to Telling Time in Spanish

Tick-tock! Join Rosa the Parrot to learn how to tell the time in Spanish!

- To ask 'What time is it?', we say: '¿Qué hora es?'
- For one o'clock, we say: 'Es la una en punto'.
- For two o'clock, we say: 'Son las dos en punto'.
- To say 'o'clock', we use the phrase: 'en punto'.
- To say 'half past', we use the phrase: 'y media'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, we use 'Es la' for one o'clock because it is singular, but we use 'Son las' for all other hours because they are plural!
