

Rosa's Daily Routine: Telling the Time in Spanish

Learning objective: To tell the time in Spanish using o'clock and half past, and to describe a daily activity.

Hello! Join Rosa the parrot to practise telling the time in Spanish. Look at the clocks in the boxes. Write the time in Spanish and draw the hands on the clock face to match. Use the sentence starters to help you.

Word bank: Es la una · Son las dos · Son las tres · Son las cuatro · y media · en punto

1. Rosa wakes up at 7 o'clock. Write the Spanish for 'It is 7 o'clock' and draw the hands on the clock. (2 marks)

2. Rosa eats lunch at half past 1. Write the Spanish for 'It is half past 1' and draw the hands on the clock. (2 marks)

3. Rosa reads a book at 4 o'clock. Write the Spanish for 'It is 4 o'clock' and draw the hands on the clock. (2 marks)

4. Rosa goes to sleep at half past 8. Write the Spanish for 'It is half past 8' and draw the hands on the clock. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Choose one time from the sheet and draw what you are doing at that time in English.
