

Telling the Time in Spanish with Rosa

Learning objective: To learn how to say 'What time is it?' and tell the time on the hour in Spanish.

Read the sentences with Rosa. Fill in the gaps to finish the Spanish time phrases. Use the word bank to help you.

Hola! I am Rosa the parrot. Today we are learning to tell the time in Spanish. To ask the time, we say: '¿Qué hora es?'. When it is exactly on the hour, we add 'en punto' at the end. For one o'clock, we say: 'Es la una en punto'. For two o'clock, we say: 'Son las dos en punto'. For three o'clock, we say: 'Son las tres en punto'.

Word bank: ¿Qué hora es? · Es la una · Son las dos · Son las tres · en punto

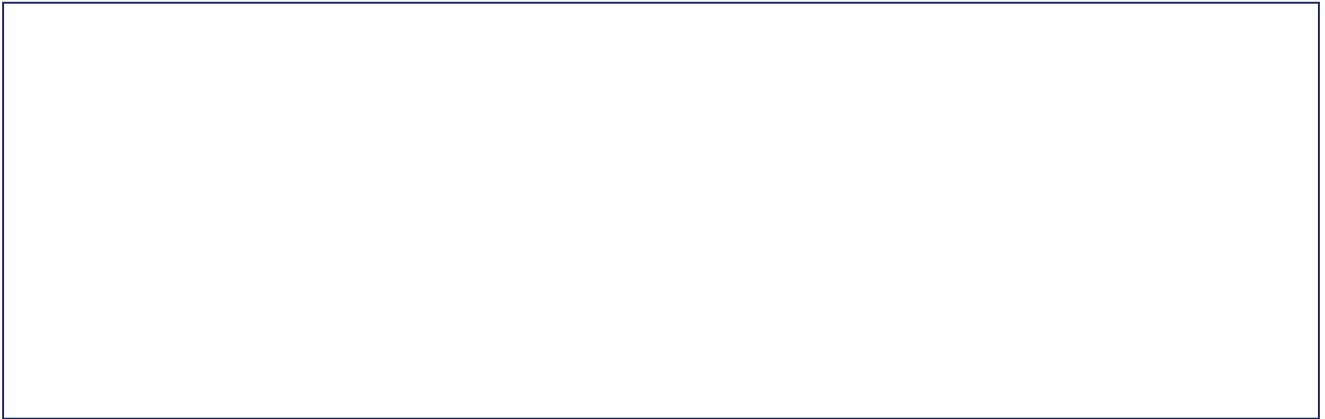
1. How do you ask 'What time is it?' in Spanish? (2 marks)
