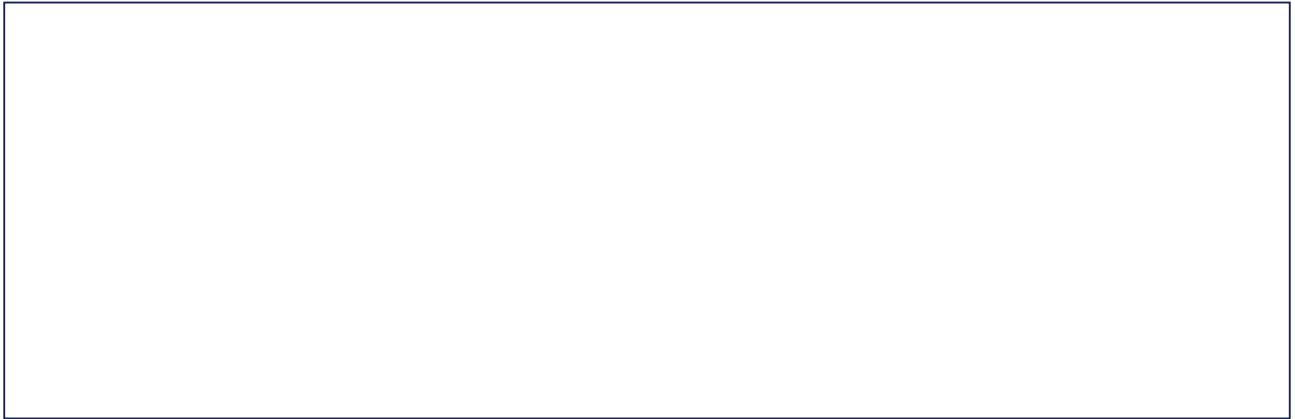

What might happen if a traveller confused 'el barco' with 'el avión' when booking a ticket? 4. Create a short Spanish sentence using one transport word (e.g., 'Voy en el tren'). 5. Justify why someone might choose 'la bicicleta' over 'el coche' for a short journey. 6. If you were building a new form of transport, what would you call it in Spanish?
