

Rosa's Spanish Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for various forms of transport and understand how to express travel preferences.

Rosa the parrot is planning a trip across Spain! Help her organise her travel plans by matching the Spanish transport words to their English meanings and then completing the sentences to describe how she likes to travel. Use the word bank to help you.

Word bank: el coche (car) · el tren (train) · el avión (aeroplane) · el autobús (bus) · la bicicleta (bicycle) · el barco (boat) · en (by/in) · prefiero (I prefer) · viajar (to travel)

1. Match the Spanish word to the English: 1. El tren, 2. La bicicleta, 3. El avión. Write the English translation next to each. (3 marks)

2. Rosa says: 'Yo prefiero viajar en ____.' (I prefer to travel by boat). Fill in the blank using the word bank. (1 mark)

3. If a bus ticket costs £4.50 and a train ticket costs £7.25, how much more does the train cost than the bus? (2 marks)

4. Translate the phrase: 'I travel by car' into Spanish using the word bank. (1 mark)

5. Why might someone choose to travel 'en bicicleta' instead of 'en avión' for a short journey? Give one reason. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot sitting on top of your favourite form of transport from the word bank. Label your drawing with the correct Spanish name.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are going on holiday with Rosa. Write two sentences in Spanish describing how you will travel. For example: 'Yo viajo en tren' (I travel by train).
