

Rosa's Spanish Verb Adventure: Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of regular Spanish verbs in the present tense, including subject pronouns and verb endings.

Read each question carefully. Use the provided word bank if you need help with vocabulary. Ensure your spellings are accurate. Good luck!

Rosa the parrot is teaching her friends how to speak Spanish. In Spanish, verbs change their endings depending on who is performing the action. Remember to match the correct person to the verb ending!

Word bank: yo (I) · tú (you) · él/ella (he/she) · nosotros (we) · ellos (they) · hablar (to speak) · comer (to eat) · vivir (to live) · bailar (to dance) · beber (to drink)

1. Identify the correct subject pronoun for the following sentence: '_____ hablo español' (I speak Spanish). (1 mark)

2. Conjugate the verb 'hablar' (to speak) for the following subjects: 1. Yo _____, 2. Tú _____. (2 marks)

3. If the verb 'comer' means 'to eat', explain the difference between 'yo como' and 'nosotros comemos'. Why does the ending change? (3 marks)

4. Translate the following into Spanish: 'She lives in a tree.' (Use the verb 'vivir' and the pronoun 'ella'). (2 marks)

5. Complete the conjugation table for the verb 'beber' (to drink): Yo _____, Tú _____, Él/Ella _____, Nosotros _____. (4 marks)

6. Compare and contrast: How are the endings for -ar verbs different from -er verbs in the 'yo' form? Give an example of each. (4 marks)

7. Create a short paragraph (4-5 sentences) in Spanish describing what you and your friends do. Use at least three different verbs and ensure the endings match the subjects. Include a translation into English. (9 marks)

Draw: Draw a scene where Rosa the parrot is teaching a class of woodland animals. Label three items in the drawing using Spanish vocabulary you have learned.



Extension challenge: Justify your answer: What might happen to the meaning of a sentence if you used the wrong verb ending? Provide an example of a mistake and explain why it would confuse a Spanish speaker.
