

Rosa's Spanish Verb Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use common Spanish verbs in the present tense, distinguishing between first, second, and third-person singular forms.

Your task is to fill in the blanks by choosing the correct verb form from the word bank. Remember: '-o' is for 'I' (yo), '-as/es' is for 'you' (tú), and '-a/e' is for 'he/she' (él/ella).

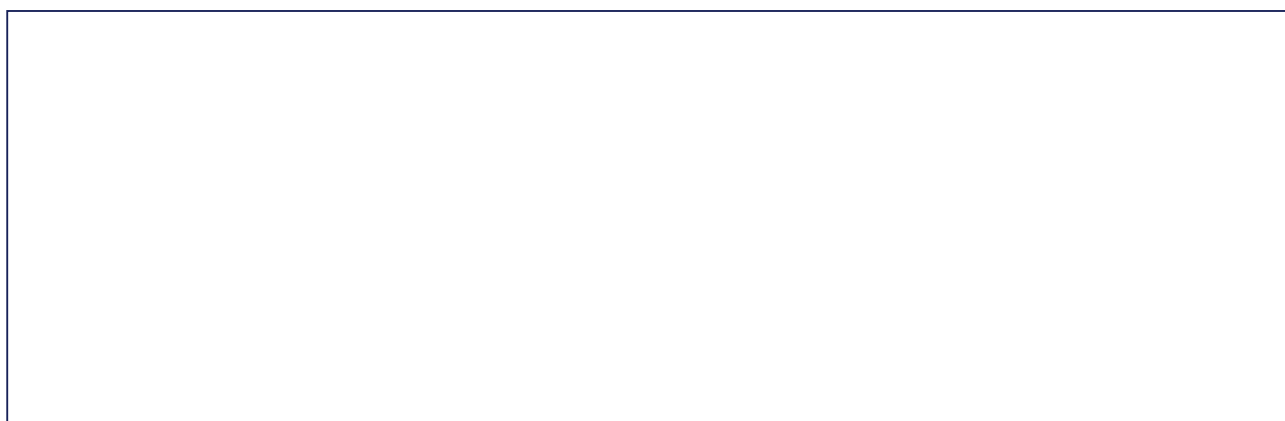
