

Rosa's Weather Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and use basic Spanish weather vocabulary.

Follow the steps below to create your Spanish weather scene. Rosa the parrot wants to see your drawings! Use the word bank to label each part of your picture.

Draw: Draw a large outdoor scene on your page. Divide your paper into four sections. In each section, draw a different type of weather. Use bright colours for the sun and soft greys for the clouds. Make your labels clear by drawing a line from the Spanish word to the correct part of your drawing.



Label words: Hace sol · Hace frío · Está nublado · Llueve · Hace viento

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big bright sun in the corner. Label it with the Spanish word for 'It is sunny'.
2. Step 2: Draw a grey cloud. Label it with the Spanish word for 'It is cloudy'.
3. Step 3: Draw a person wearing a coat. Label it with the Spanish word for 'It is cold'.
4. Step 4: Draw raindrops falling from the sky. Label it with the Spanish word for 'It is raining'.
