

El Tiempo: Weather Around the World with Rosa

- When you look out of the window and see grey clouds covering the sky, you would say 'Está nublado'.
- If you are packing for a summer holiday in Madrid, you should prepare for 'hace calor'.
- If you hear the pitter-patter of raindrops against the glass, you can tell your friends 'Llueve'.
- Always remember to ask '¿Qué tiempo hace?' if you want to know what the weather is doing today.
- During the winter months in the Pyrenees mountains, you will often find that 'nieva'.

Did you know? Did you know? Because Spain is quite a large country, the weather can be very different depending on where you are! While the southern coast might be basking in 'hace sol' near the Mediterranean Sea, the high mountain ranges in the north can experience 'nieva' even during the spring months.
