

El Tiempo: Talking About the Weather

Join Rosa the parrot and become a weather expert in Spanish!

- Rosa says: 'Hace sol' when the sun is shining brightly in the sky.
- If you need a coat because the temperature is low, you say: 'Hace frío'.
- When the grey clouds cover the sky, we say: 'Está nublado'.
- If you hear pitter-patter on the window, it is raining: 'Llueve'.
- When your hat might blow away in a breeze, it is: 'Hace viento'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spain, people often ask '¿Qué tiempo hace?' to start a conversation. It is a great way to talk about the day before heading out to play!
