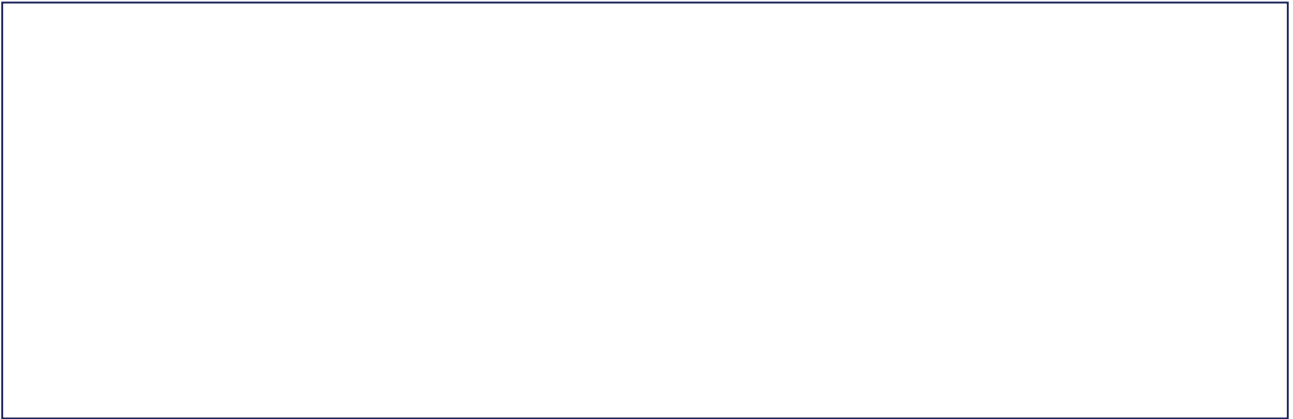
7. 7. Fill in the blank: If the ground is covered in white, frozen flakes, we say _____. (1 mark)

Create a weather forecast script for Rosa using at least four different weather phrases. 5. If Rosa wanted to pack a suitcase for a trip to a place where 'Nieva', what items would she need? 6. Justify why it is useful for travellers to learn basic weather phrases.
