

Rosa's Weather Diary

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish weather vocabulary to describe the conditions outside.

Hello! I am Rosa the parrot. Today, we are going to be weather reporters. Look out of your window. Use the Spanish words in the word bank to fill in the diary. You can use the sentence starters to help you.

Word bank: Hace sol (It is sunny) · Hace frío (It is cold) · Hace calor (It is hot) · Está lloviendo (It is raining) · Está nublado (It is cloudy)

3. Is it hot or cold? [Use a sentence starter: Hace...] (2 marks)
