

Rosa's Weather Report

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish words for the weather.

Read the sentences about the weather. Match the Spanish word to the picture or description. Use the word bank to help you complete the sentences.

Hola! I am Rosa. Today, I am looking at the weather. In Spain, the weather changes a lot. When the sun is out, we say 'Hace sol'. When it is cold, we say 'Hace frío'. If it is raining, we say 'Llueve'. When it is hot, we say 'Hace calor'. If the sky is covered in clouds, we say 'Está nublado'.

Word bank: Hace sol · Hace frío · Llueve · Hace calor · Está nublado

2. 2. It is raining outside. Write the Spanish word for 'It is raining'. (2 marks)

3. 3. The sky is full of clouds. Write the Spanish words for 'It is cloudy'. (2 marks)

4. 4. You are wearing a warm coat. Write the Spanish words for 'It is cold'. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite type of weather and write the correct Spanish phrase underneath it.

Extension challenge: Can you ask a friend '¿Qué tiempo hace?' and tell them the weather today?
