

Rosa's Weather Report: El Tiempo

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish phrases to describe the weather.

Rosa the parrot wants to help you talk about the weather in Spanish. Look at the pictures and the word bank. Use the sentence starters to help you write your answers.

Word bank: Hace sol - It is sunny · Hace frío - It is cold · Hace calor - It is hot · Llueve - It is raining · Está nublado - It is cloudy

1. If the sun is shining brightly, how do we say 'It is sunny' in Spanish? Use the sentence starter: 'Hoy...' (2 marks)

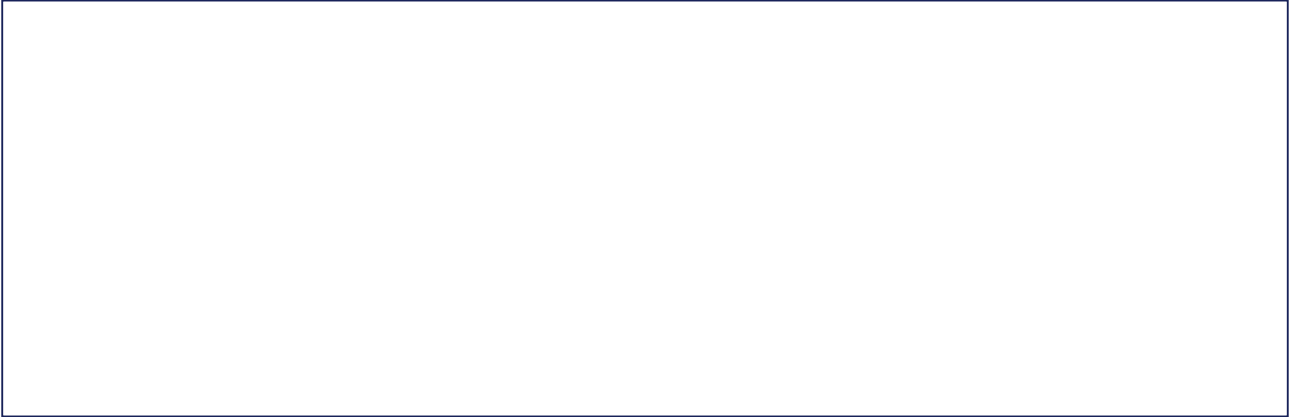
2. Rosa is wearing a jumper because it is chilly. How do we say 'It is cold' in Spanish? Use the sentence starter: 'Hoy...' (2 marks)

3. Look at the sky. If there are many grey clouds, how do we say 'It is cloudy' in Spanish? (2 marks)

4. If you need an umbrella because water is falling from the sky, how do we say 'It is raining' in Spanish? (2 marks)

5. If it is a very warm day, how do we say 'It is hot' in Spanish? (2 marks)
