

Sheet 17: Rhyming Fun with Pip

Worked example:

Read this rhyme: Pip the bug likes to eat a fig. Does 'bug' rhyme with 'fig'? No. Does 'big' rhyme with 'fig'? Yes.

Answer: big and fig

- **Read this rhyme: Pip sits on a mat. He wears a tall hat.**

mat hat

- **Look at the word 'cat'. Circle the word below that rhymes with it: dog, bat, sun.**

dog bat sun

- **Look at the word 'pin'. Circle the word below that rhymes with it: bin, top, red.**

bin top red

- **Read this rhyme: Pip sees a bright light. It shines in the night.**

light night

- **Draw a line to match the rhyming words: 1. hop, 2. pen. Words: hen, mop.**

hop - mop pen - hen

Self-check: Check that the two words in each pair end with the same sound.
