Worked example:

Read the story: Pip the caterpillar woke up. He ate a leaf. He spun a cocoon. He turned into a butterfly. Which happened first?

Answer: Pip woke up.

- **Read the story about Max the monkey. Number the sentences 1, 2, 3, and 4 to show what happened first to last: Max found a banana. He peeled the skin. He ate the fruit. He felt very happy.**

- **Read the story about Leo the lion. Number the sentences 1, 2, 3, and 4: Leo found a quiet spot. He opened his notebook. He wrote a poem. He read it to his friends.**
