

Sheet 16: Reading Review Challenge

Worked example:

Read this: 'Pip the caterpillar munched a leaf and felt very sleepy.' Question: How is Pip feeling? Answer: Pip is feeling tired/sleepy.

Answer: Pip is feeling tired.

- **Read this fiction snippet: 'Max the monkey looked at his pile of 5 bananas. He ate 2 and felt full. He saved the rest for later.'**

Why did Max stop eating? How many bananas are left for later?

- **Read this non-fiction snippet: 'Honeybees like Bea are very important. They fly from flower to flower collecting nectar. This helps plants grow new seeds.'**

What does Bea collect from flowers? Why is it important that bees visit flowers?

- **Look at the fiction snippet again. What does the word 'saved' tell us about Max's planning?**

Max is thinking about the future.

- **Look at the non-fiction snippet. Is this text trying to tell a story or explain a process?**

It is explaining a process.

- **If Max had 10 bananas and ate 3, how many would he have left? (Show your maths!)**

$10 - 3 = 7$

Self-check: Check your answers against the facts in the text to ensure you didn't guess information that wasn't there.
