

Sheet 9: Adding 1-digit numbers to 2-digit numbers

Worked example:

Max has 23 bananas and finds 4 more. $23 + 4 = ?$

Answer: Look at the ones column: $3 + 4 = 7$. Keep the 2 tens. The answer is 27.

- Solve these additions by adding the ones:

$$31 + 2 = 44 + 3 = 62 + 5 =$$

- Max found more items. Calculate the totals:

$$50 + 8 = 71 + 6 = 83 + 4 =$$

- Max went to the shop. He spent £22 on fruit and £7 on seeds. How much did he spend in total?

$$£22 + £7 = £$$

Self-check: Check your answers by adding the ones column first, then writing the tens digit back in front.
