1. Personal Information: Explain why you should never share your full name, home address, or school name online. What should you do if a website asks for these details? (3 marks)

2. Strong Passwords: Kit says passwords are like secret keys. What are three things that make a password 'strong' and secure? (3 marks)

3. Recognising Risks: If you see something online that makes you feel worried, sad, or uncomfortable, what are the steps you should take? (3 marks)

4. Kindness Online: How can you ensure your behavior online reflects your behavior in the classroom? Give an example of being a good digital citizen. (2 marks)

5. The Digital Footprint: Explain what a 'digital footprint' is and why it is important to think before you mail or share anything. (2 marks)
