Learning objective: To identify, use, and evaluate the impact of adjectives to enhance descriptive writing.

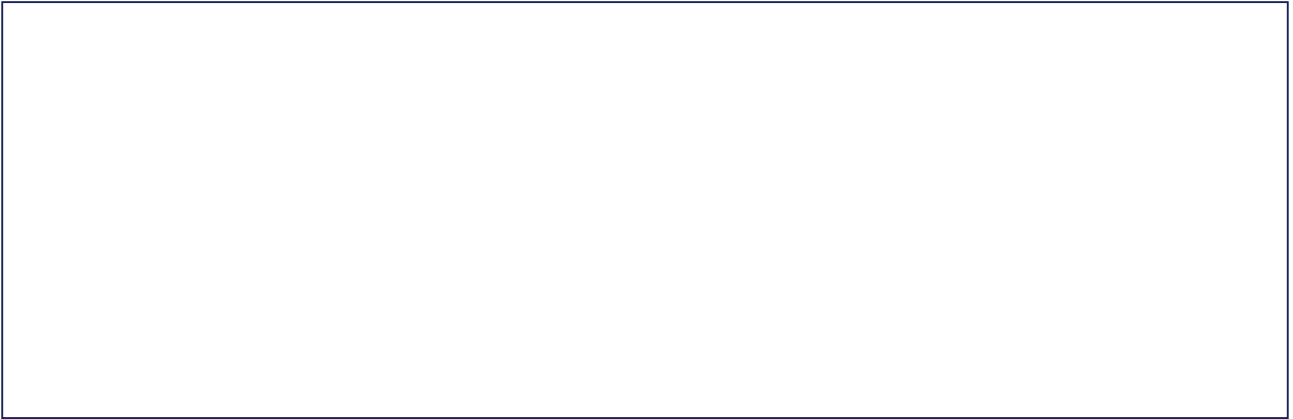
7. 7. Fill in the blank with an appropriate adjective: 'The _____ stars twinkled in the night sky.' (1 mark)
