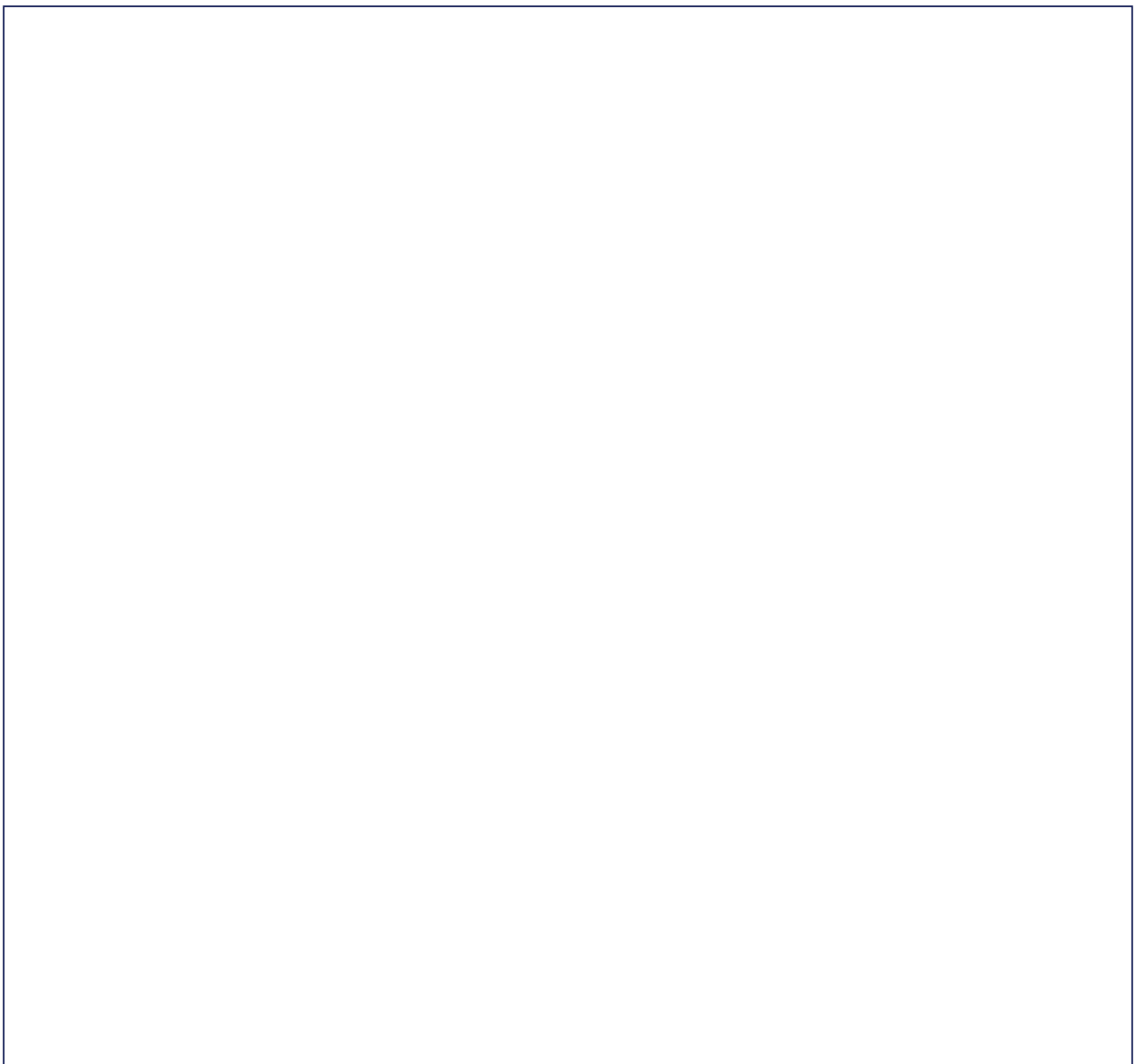


# Celebrating Pioneers: Black History Month

*Learning objective: To learn about the achievements of influential Black figures and practice descriptive writing through labelling.*

Read the facts about these inspiring people, color in the scene, and complete the labels to show what you have learned about their achievements.

## Steps:
