

My Black History Hero Fact-File

Learning objective: To research and record facts about a significant person from Black history, using simple sentences and key vocabulary.

Today, we are going to learn about a person who has made a big difference in the world. Choose someone you have learned about this month. Use this fact-file to tell me all about them! Remember to use capital letters for names and full stops at the end of your sentences.

Word bank: brave · kind · leader · inventor · history · change · important · inspiring

1. Name of my hero: Write the name of the person you have chosen to write about. (1 mark)

2. What they are famous for: Tell me why this person is remembered in history. (2 marks)

3. A special fact: Write one interesting thing you discovered about their life. (2 marks)

4. My favorite thing: What do you like most about this person? (1 mark)

5. Why they are a hero: Explain why you think this person made the world a better place. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a colorful portrait of your hero. Show them doing something they are famous for, like speaking to a crowd, inventing something, or helping others.



Extension challenge: Ask Ellie the elephant for help! Write one extra sentence about how this person's actions changed history for people today.
