

Nova's Bonfire Night Adventure

Learning objective: To develop vocabulary and descriptive language by sequencing sounds and sights associated with Bonfire Night.

Nova the owl is watching the night sky. Look at the list of words below. Help Nova sort the words into two groups: things she can SEE during a firework display and things she can HEAR. Write the words in the correct box or draw a line to match them to the right column.

Word bank: bang · sparkle · whizz · colorful · pop · bright · crackle · glow

1. 1. Nova sees a bright light in the sky. Can you name two other things she might see? (2 marks)

2. 2. When a firework goes 'bang', how does that sound make you feel? Use a describing word. (1 mark)

3. 3. If a sparkler costs £1, and you have £2, how many sparklers could you buy? (1 mark)

4. 4. Why do we celebrate Bonfire Night? Tell us one thing you know about why we have fires. (2 marks)

5. 5. Which firework sound is your favorite? Write the word down. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a firework display in the night sky. Make sure to include lots of bright colors and shapes like stars or circles.



Extension challenge: Ask a grown-up to help you find a poem about Bonfire Night. Can you find a rhyming word for 'bright' or 'glow'?
