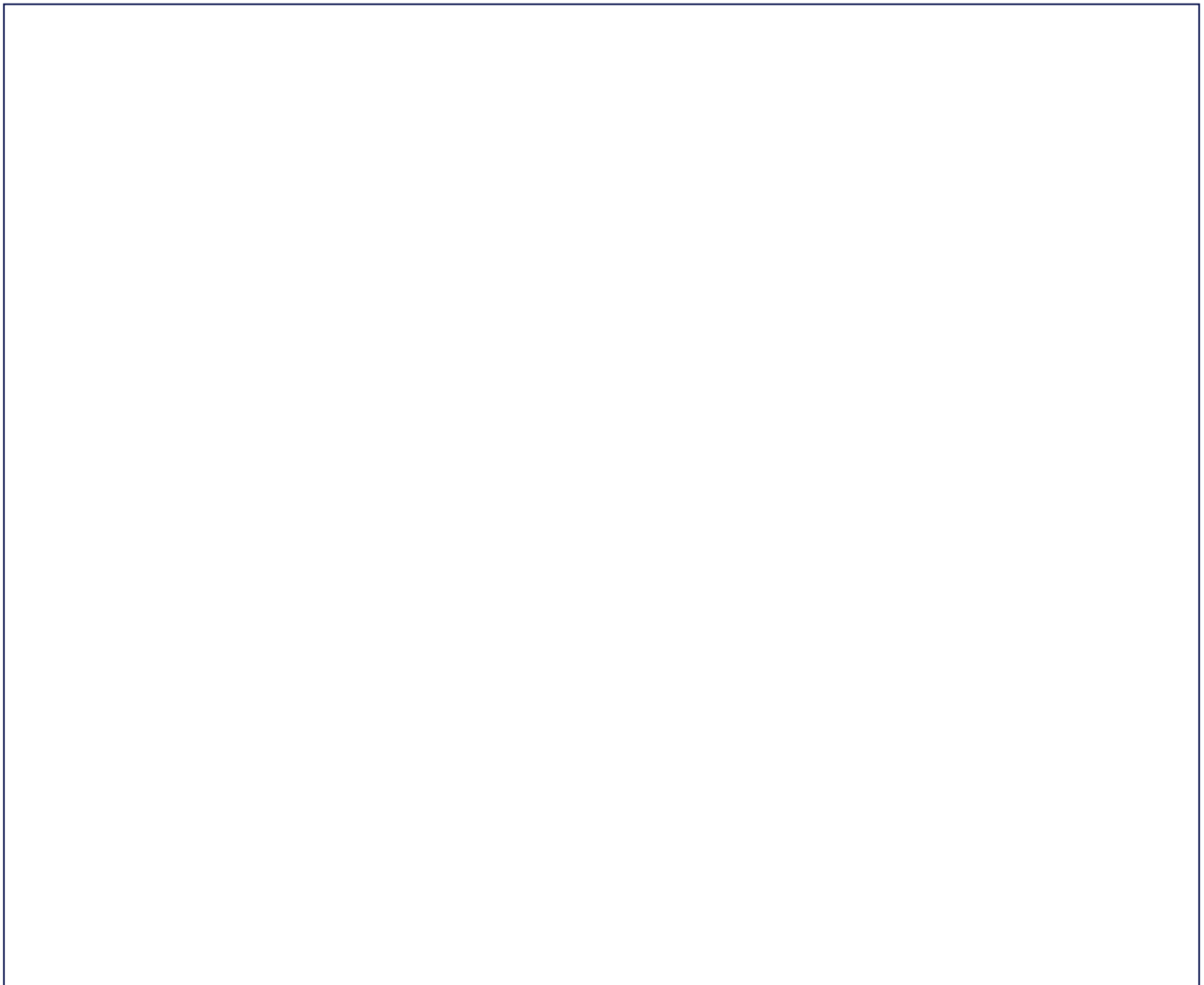


Nova's Bonfire Night Adventure

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills and phonic knowledge by drawing and labelling a seasonal scene.

Follow the drawing prompts to create your own Bonfire Night picture. Use the word bank to help you label the different parts of your drawing.

Draw: Create a landscape-style drawing of a Bonfire Night scene. The style should be bright and colorful against a dark night sky. Include a crackling bonfire with orange, red, and yellow flames at the bottom. Fill the sky above with shimmering stars and swirling patterns to represent fireworks. Add a small figure of a child standing at a safe distance, looking up at the sky in wonder.



Label words: fire · sparkle · sky · night · glow

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big, bright bonfire in the middle of your page. What colors will you use for the flames?
2. Step 2: Draw some squiggly lines above the bonfire to show the smoke drifting into the air.
3. Step 3: Draw stars in the sky and add some dots to show sparks flying up high.
4. Step 4: Use a label from the word bank to point to the fire. Which word describes the fire best?
5. Step 5: Draw yourself standing safely near the bonfire watching the lights.
