1. What is the name of the protagonist in the story Pip reviewed? (1 mark)

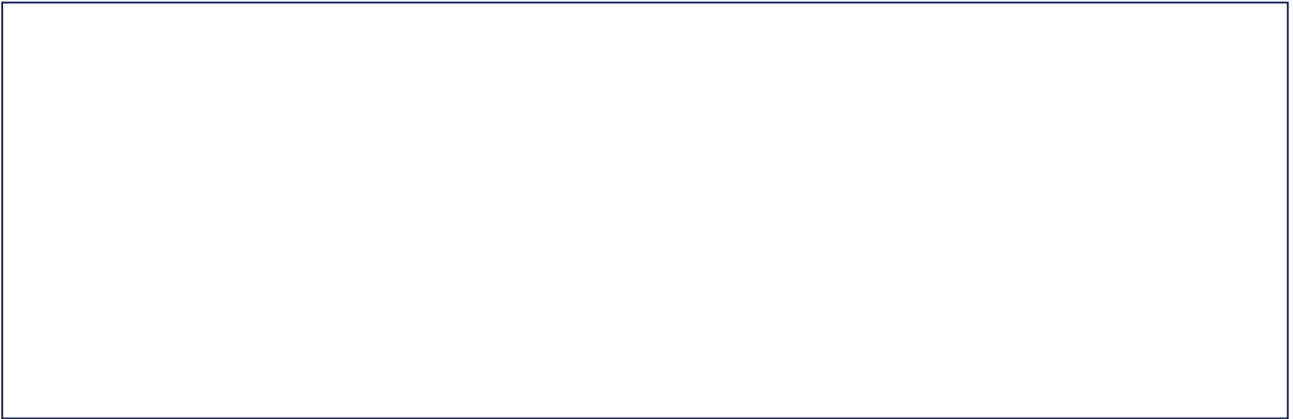
2. How much does the book cost according to the review? (1 mark)
