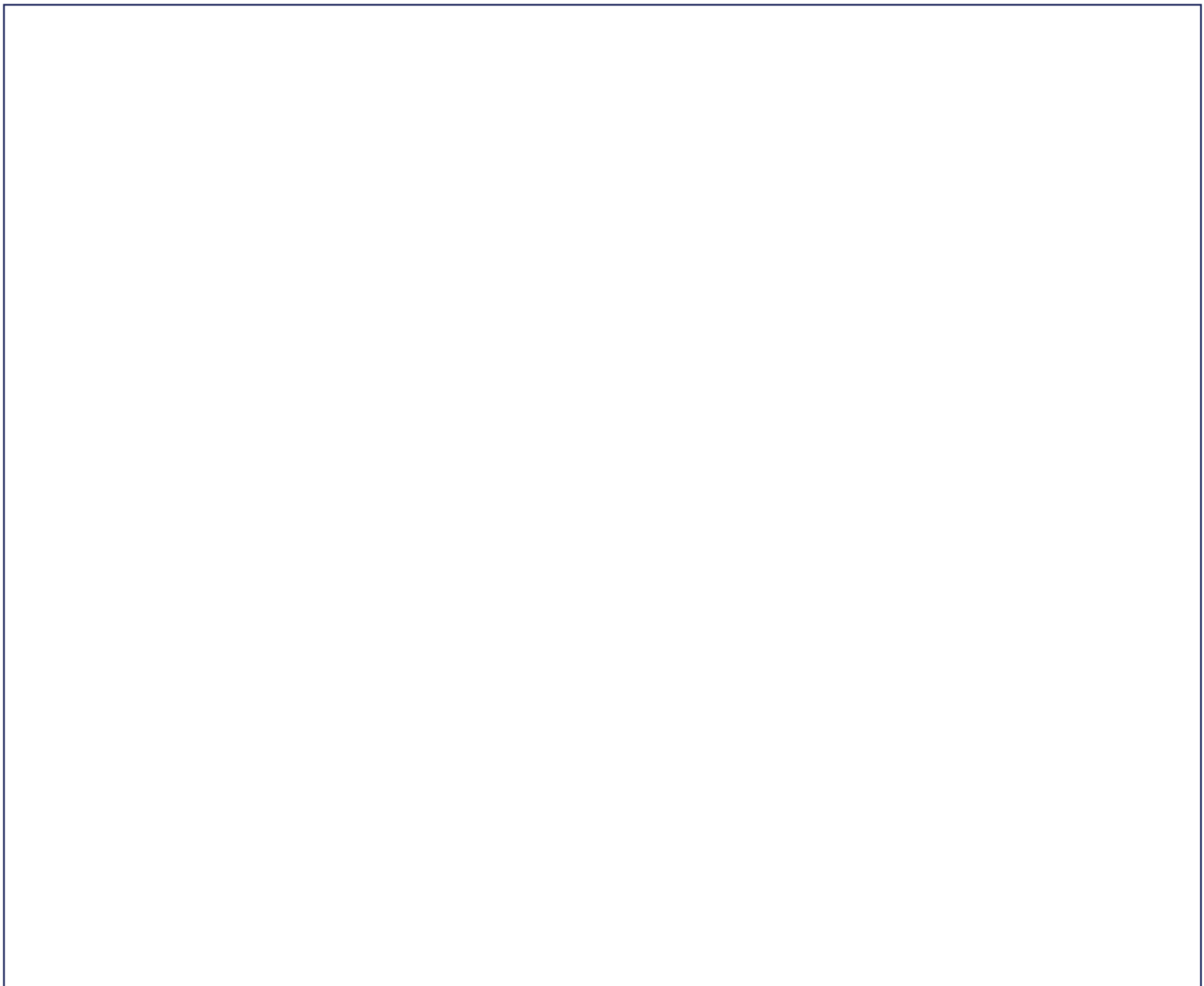


Pip's Book Review Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To express personal responses to a book by drawing and labelling key elements such as characters and settings.

Think about your favorite storybook. Use the space below to draw a scene from that story. Use the word bank to help you label your picture so Pip the caterpillar knows exactly what is happening!

Draw: Create a large, clear drawing area. The style should be open and inviting for a 5-6 year old. The scene should show a main character in a specific setting. Include five small star shapes at the bottom of the page for the child to color in to rate their book.



Label words: character · setting · adventure · favorite part · hero · exciting

Steps:

1. Draw a picture of your favorite character from the book in the box below.
2. Label your drawing using at least two words from the word bank.
3. What was the setting of your story? (e.g., a forest, a castle, or a space station)
4. Why did you choose this as your favorite part? Write one short sentence.
5. Give your book review a score out of 5 stars by coloring in the stars below.
