

Pip's Reading Adventure: My Book Review

Learning objective: To express preferences and opinions about a story, developing the ability to communicate thoughts about what has been read.

Help Pip the bookworm share his favorite stories! Read a book together and encourage the child to fill in this review template. Support them by writing down their ideas if they are still developing their phonic knowledge. Discuss why they liked or disliked parts of the story.

Word bank: funny · exciting · happy · favorite · character · story · adventure · interesting · kind

1. Book Title: What is the name of the book you read? Write it here.

2. My Rating: Color in the stars to show how much you liked the story (1 to 5 stars).

3. The Characters: Who was your favorite character in the book and why?

4. My Favorite Part: What happened in the story that you liked the most?

5. Recommendation: Would you tell a friend to read this book? Why?

Draw: Draw a picture of the most exciting part of the story in the box below.



Extension challenge: Ask the child to pretend they are Pip the bookworm and explain to a friend why they should read this book using at least two words from the word bank.
