

Easter Stories with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and visual representation to retell a story about springtime and new beginnings.

Ellie the Elephant has been reading stories about the traditions of Easter. Use the space below to draw your own picture of an Easter garden. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a vibrant spring garden scene. Include a woven basket on a patch of green grass, decorated eggs hidden behind flowers, and a bright yellow sun in the sky. Use clear lines and bright colors to show that it is a happy, sunny day.



Label words: flowers · basket · eggs · spring · garden · sunshine

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large basket in the middle of your page. What will you put inside the basket?
2. Step 2: Draw two colorful flowers next to your basket. What colors are your flowers?
3. Step 3: Draw a bright sun in the corner of your page to show it is a lovely spring day.
4. Label your drawing using at least three words from the word bank provided.
5. Write one sentence to describe what is happening in your garden scene.
