

My Character Profile: A Creative Writing Adventure

Learning objective: To use adjectives and expanded noun phrases to describe a character, using capital letters and full stops correctly.

Help Zara the zebra bring a new character to life! Use the sections below to describe your character. Remember to use exciting adjectives to make your writing sparkle. Check that every sentence starts with a capital letter and ends with a full stop or exclamation mark.

1. Character Name and Appearance: Write the name of your character and describe what they look like. Use an expanded noun phrase (e.g., 'The fluffy, grey rabbit'). (3 marks)

2. Personality and Hobbies: What is your character like? Do they like to play, read, or explore? Use a conjunction like 'and' or 'because' to join your ideas. (3 marks)

3. The Character's Home: Where does your character live? Describe their house using at least two adjectives. (2 marks)

4. Special Power or Talent: Does your character have a special skill? Write one sentence about what they can do. (2 marks)

5. A Question for Zara: Write a question you would like to ask Zara the zebra about your new character. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write a short story on a separate piece of paper about your character going on an adventure with Zara?
