

Max's Magnificent Math Store: A Grammar Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives and conjunctions to expand sentences accurately.

Help Max the monkey organize his store by completing the grammar tasks below. Use your best handwriting and check your spelling.

Max is busy sorting items for his store. He has some items to label, but he needs your help to make his sentences more interesting and descriptive.

Word bank: sparkling · because · enormous · although · tiny · when · bright · if

1. Max has a pencil. Add two adjectives to describe the pencil and rewrite the sentence below. (2 marks)

2. Max wants to sell a bag. Combine these two sentences using the conjunction 'because': 'The bag is heavy. It is full of gold coins.' (2 marks)

3. Circle the conjunctions in this list: although, red, when, fast, if, giant. (2 marks)

4. Write a sentence about a store item that costs £5. You must include one adjective and one conjunction from the word bank. (3 marks)

5. Max has an 'enormous' apple and a 'tiny' pear. Explain why these two words are adjectives. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey standing in his store. Include at least three items for sale and label each item using an adjective (e.g., 'a shiny watch', 'a colorful hat').



Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph (3-4 sentences) describing what happens when a customer enters Max's store. Use at least two different conjunctions (e.g., when, because, although) to connect your ideas.
