

Grammar Explorer Flashcards with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and use nouns, verbs, adjectives, and basic punctuation marks as expected in the Kindergarten National Curriculum.

Read the front of the card to see the grammar challenge. Max the Monkey wants you to solve the puzzle! Check the back of the card to see if you got it right.

What is a noun?

A noun is a naming word for a person, place, or thing.

Identify the noun in this sentence: Max eats a banana.

Max or banana.

What is a verb?

A verb is an action word, like jump, run, or eat.

Identify the verb in this sentence: The owl flies high.

flies.

What is an adjective?

An adjective is a word that describes a noun, like 'shiny' or 'big'.

Identify the adjective in this sentence: The kind elephant smiles.

kind.

What must every sentence start with?

A capital letter.

What mark goes at the end of a statement?

A full stop (.).

What mark goes at the end of this sentence: Where is Pip?

A question mark (?).

Fix this sentence: the cat sits.

The cat sits.

Is 'red' a noun, a verb, or an adjective?

An adjective.

Is 'jump' a noun, a verb, or an adjective?

A verb.
