

Max the Monkey's Grammar Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences.

Read the story about Max the Monkey. Look closely at the sentences. Use a colored pencil to circle the capital letters and underline the full stops. Then, answer the questions below.

Max is a happy monkey. He lives in a big green jungle. Today, Max found a yellow banana. He sat on a branch to eat it. The banana was very sweet. Max felt happy.

1. How many sentences are in the story about Max? (1 mark)

2. Why does every sentence start with a capital letter? (2 marks)

3. Write a new sentence about Max using a capital letter and a full stop. (2 marks)

4. Find the word 'banana' in the passage. What letter does it start with? (1 mark)

5. If Max bought a banana for 20p and an apple for 30p, how much did he spend in total? Show your working. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey eating his banana in the jungle. Make sure you draw a tree and some leaves!



Extension challenge: Write two more sentences about what Max might do next. Remember to use a capital letter at the start of each sentence and a full stop at the end.
