6. 6. True or False: Myths always feature modern-day technology like aeroplanes and computers. (1 mark)

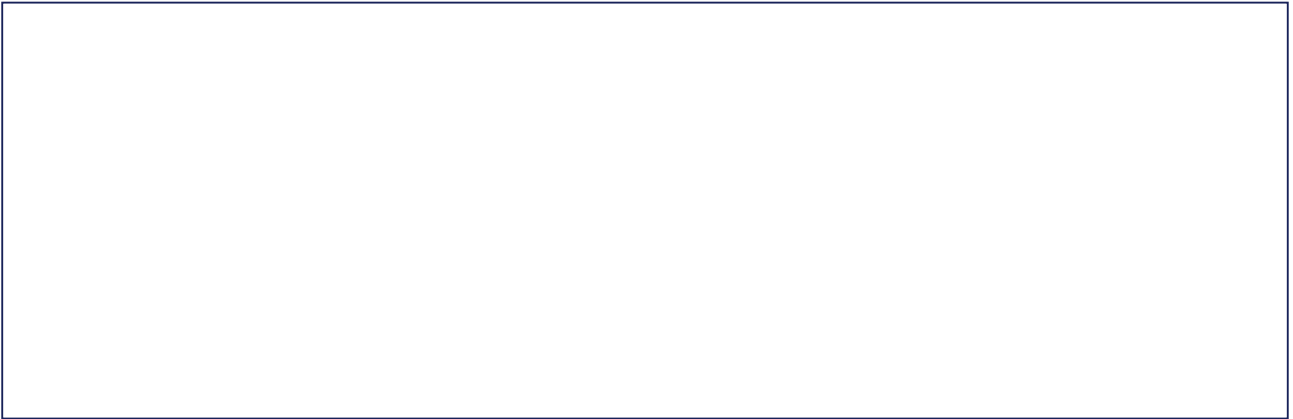
