6. 6. Fill in the blank: Max—who loves bananas—climbed the tree. What punctuation was used? (Dashes / Exclamation marks) (1 mark)

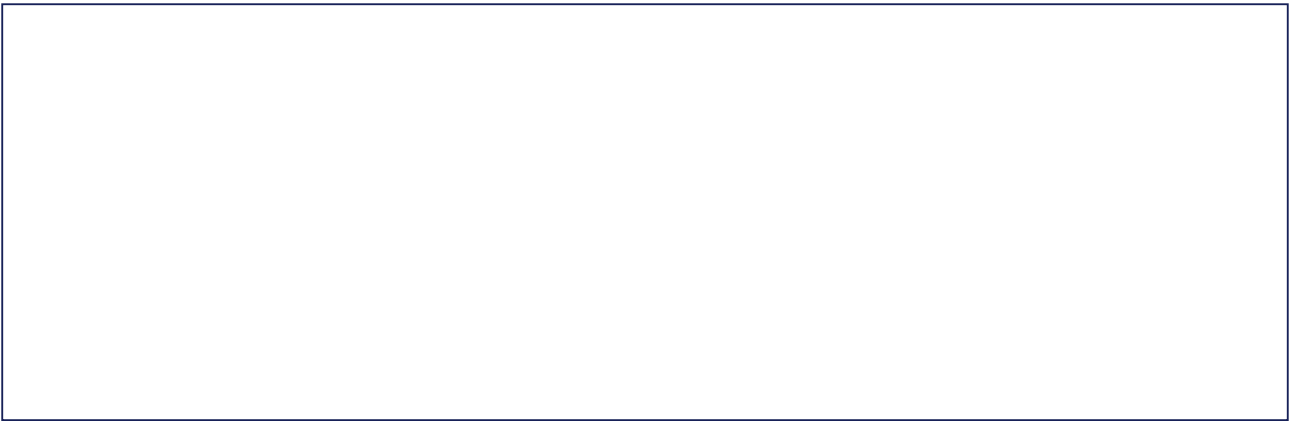
7. 7. Which punctuation mark is used here: Pip, a small caterpillar, loves reading books? (1 mark)
