Learning objective: To correctly use capital letters, full stops, question marks, and exclamation marks in sentences.

Max the monkey has opened a store, but his signs are missing all their punctuation! Help Max fix his store by choosing the correct punctuation mark for the end of each sentence from the word bank. Write the correct punctuation mark in the space provided at the end of each sentence.
